Airline Tips:

- Airfare is generally cheapest when traveling on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday or Saturday.
- For the smoothest flight, choose a seat over the wings of the plane.
- Consider your alternatives when booking airfare. Fares can vary widely from neighboring airports.
- **Always** confirm your flights 24 hours before departure.

Hotel Tips:

- If you haven't left your valuables at home, leave them in your hotel's safe.
- When leaving your room, place your "Do Not Disturb" sign on your door. This will detract any would-be thieves from breaking in.

Traveling Abroad:

- When traveling in a foreign country, banks usually provide the best exchange rates.
- Always be aware of your surroundings, and stick to the main roads.

Miscellaneous:

- Booking your vacation as a package is almost always cheaper than arranging airfare, hotel and car separately.
- Traveler's checks offer you more protection than cash and are widely accepted.

Cruise Tips:

- There are two ways to get the best price on a cruise: book early or book at the very last minute. Both will save you money, but early bookers get the best choice of cabins for roughly the same "sale" price as late bookers—and avoid being disappointed because their ship is sold out. "Early" usually means three to six months before the cruise; the savings generally are 25 to 50 percent off the published brochure price per person.
- Pack light! Most people tend to over-pack. A good rule of thumb is to pack and then remove half of the items. Remember, cabins can be small and you don't want to be tripping over your luggage.
- Schedule shore excursions and spa treatments in advance as early as possible so you won't miss out on anything you'd like to do.
